

**Participant Instructions for GOLD’N Parents Appreciation Day  
at Camp Whitewood**

Participant agrees to abide by all rules established by the Instructor(s), and that failure to abide by those rules will prohibit further participation in the event.

Participants must be at least 21 years of age, except for youths/children, for whom an adult parent/guardian has signed the Release/Waiver form and the Consent for Possession of Handgun by Juvenile form. Participants must not be under any legal disability from handling or otherwise possessing firearms.

Documentation:

*Waiver/Release of Liability:* Please review and sign this form. It must be signed in order to participate. Bring it with you to the main lodge. The forms will be collected prior to the range time, which begins at 12:30 p.m.

*Juvenile Possession of Handgun Consent Form:* Parents/guardians who plan to have their children participate must sign this form and provide it to the GOLD’N volunteers.

*Photo Release Form:* Participants must sign this form. Any imagery obtained during the Parents Appreciation Day may be used by Camp Whitewood and/or GOLD’N for promotional purposes. Parents/guardians may sign this form on behalf of their children.

Handguns:

Only handguns are permitted during range instruction (i.e., no long guns). Participants are invited to bring with them their own handguns and ammunition. The GOLD’N instructors also will provide several handguns and ammunition for those participants who lack them.

Transporting Your Handguns:

Please arrive at Camp Whitewood with your handguns safely secured. If you are a licensed concealed-carrier, we ask that you keep your firearms concealed until you arrive at the firing range. Also, we ask that no live ammunition be present in the main lodge during the instructional seminar period from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., and that no live ammunition be present in the dining hall during meal times. For example, we ask that you leave your handgun and/or ammunition safely secured in your vehicle during these periods.

Ammunition:

We ask participants to provide their own handgun(s) and ammunition. For those participants who do not possess a handgun, several handguns and ammunition will be

made available for their use at the firing range. Also, please bring your preferred hearing protection. Extra hearing protection muffs and ear plugs will be available.

We ask all participants to secure their handguns and ammunition in their vehicles until instructed otherwise. This is for simplicity as we prepare to travel from the main camp area, where the dining hall and main lodge are located, to the firing range 200 yards away. The details for that journey are explained below in the Schedule and Format section of these instructions.

No reloaded rounds are permitted (NRA Policy). Only commercial ammunition is permitted.

Lead-nosed bullets are preferred over metal jacketed bullets. Copper-coated .22 caliber rounds are not considered metal jacketed bullets. If you have only metal-jacketed ammunition, we ask you to inform your instructors who will place you in designated shooting lanes where metal jacketed ammunition will be permitted.

#### Schedule and Format:

Breakfast is served from 9:30 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. in the dining hall adjacent to the main lodge.

GOLD'N will present a multimedia educational seminar in the main lodge from 10:00 a.m. until 12 Noon covering four topics, as described in the GOLD'N event flyer. No live ammunition is permitted in the main lodge at any time, including during the two (2) hour seminar.

Lunch is served in the dining hall from 12 Noon until 12:30 p.m.

Thereafter, participants will be organized into groups and escorted by GOLD'N volunteer from the main camp area to the firing range. You will be escorted back to the camp's main area after your range time.

Bullet Counts: Camp Whitewood counts how many bullets are shot in each lane of the firing range. We will also do our best to keep track of the caliber/gauge of what is shot too. Your instructors will explain the details upon your arrival at the firing range.
